“Jesus went up the mountain and summoned those whom he wanted and they came to him.” Today we heard that Jesus made public the twelve men He chose to be His closest confidants, students and fellow preachers and healers. He knew each of these men by this time and their personalities and abilities that would benefit His ministry and the beginnings of the church after He is gone.

God also knows each of us by name, He knows the number of hairs on our heads, and He has also chosen us to be His follower, student, and evangelizer. He has a plan for each of us, just as Jesus knew how each of the twelve men could uniquely add to His plan of spreading the gospel message.
