

### Love in Deed

It's a Wonderful Life is one of my favorite Christmas movies. It only occurred to me recently, though, that this film, for all its yuletide aesthetic, is actually more of an Easter story.

I love this movie because it's a very Catholic film — not overtly, although we

do see the main character, George Bailey, going to Mass. No, it's the themes that are Catholic, not the set dressing. It's a story about the choices we make — to love, or not to love? To sacrifice, or not to sacrifice? To put oneself first, or to put oneself last? It's a story about what the consequences of those choices look like here in the world, and what they look like in heaven.

In the film, we meet a young George Bailey who dreams of growing up to do amazing, impressive things. Over the years, he makes a choice here and he makes a choice there ... and when all is said and done, the adult George Bailey is a tired, overworked husband and father with no worldly attributes that anyone would envy.

But he's a man who has loved in deed, not just in word, and who has reaped the spiritual rewards of those choices

The season of Easter is about rejoicing in true redemption, not in worldly triumph. The Word of God is not a bedtime story. It's a pruning shear. To hear it is to be changed, to be shaped. To live it is to lose some things, so that you might bloom in unexpected ways. To welcome the Word is to be willing to look different, to feel different.

Anyone can say, "I love you, I accept you, I want to help you." But what does it actually look like, to love in deed and not just in word? It looks like giving something up: free time, wealth, comfort, worldly approval. It looks, to the casual observer, like pain.

To someone who has no concept of how plants grow and thrive, a gardener's pruning shears look like an executioner's sword. To someone who has no concept of how souls grow and thrive, a tomb barred by a stone looks like the end of a story, when in fact it's just the beginning.

"Children, let us love not in word or speech, but in deed and truth." — 1 John 3:18



# MIDDLE SCHOOL BATHROOM PROJECT: Update & Call to Action

The middle school bathrooms have been slated for renovation since 2021. Anyone who has used those bathrooms understands the need to renovate them. Over the past couple of years, many people have put in time to get quotes, decide the scope of the project, etc. This project is now in the final scoping and planning process with the selected contractor and architect. The work will begin in early June and provide much needed improvements in safety, cleanliness, and overall quality. The scope of the project grew significantly after more detailed expert walk-throughs of the

existing facilities.

A simple update of the existing bathrooms is no longer possible. The current bathrooms are too small to accommodate ADA compliant facilities, contain asbestos in structural components, and rely on old and constricted galvanized piping that cannot deliver adequate water flow to meet the bathroom's needs.



The new bathrooms will now

be built in the current footprint of the larger neighboring locker rooms. The bathrooms will feature all new components, including ADA compliant toilets and new structural plumbing directly from the building's water service. The result will deliver facilities that are equivalent to the high quality of education at Our Lady of the Wayside. These bathrooms are used by the entire parish at events inside the gymnasium and during parish/community gatherings; VBS, Parish Picnic, Oktoberfest, sporting events, Faith Into Action (after Sunday Mass) and CFM events. This is a parish renovation project.

This new scope requires additional, unanticipated funding from the Parish, and we need help from our entire community. Over \$130,000 has already been donated by generous families and parishioners towards the bathroom renovations. **We need an additional \$170,000 to cover the entire project.** We are asking for your prayerful consideration of a donation towards this renovation – in support of our students, faculty and parish community – as we continue to invest in modernizing the campus at Our Lady of the Wayside.

Our goal is to achieve 80% of our fundraising number by the project kickoff date (June 17th). We will keep track of our fundraising progress, along with construction progress, and provide updates to the parish through the bulletin and parish website.

Due to the evolving nature and short timelines of this project, we included a list of common questions and answers on the following page. ### Middle School Bathroom Project – Common Questions:

### Will the bathroom renovation still start on time?

Yes. Parish leaders are finalizing the project and contract details with a contractor approved by the archdiocese. Work will begin when school ends in June and be complete by the start of the next school year in August. The goal is to completely fund the project to sustain our current financial health and ability to respond to future unknown challenges. The plan allows for school to open on schedule in the event the project takes longer than expected.

### Why can't we just replace the fixtures (toilets, sinks) and tile in the existing bathrooms?

The construction planning and site-review process revealed structural deficiencies with the current bathrooms (that are original to the school and over 50 years old). The older building materials contain asbestos. The galvanized plumbing is constricted from decades of buildup and can't deliver water pressure to multiple sinks and water fountains at the same time. The current bathroom footprint is small and makes it impossible to meet the standards of the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). There is no way to properly retrofit the existing facilities to meet the current needs of our school and parish. The new scope is the most cost-effective way to provide proper bathroom facilities for the middle school building.

### Why do we need to raise an additional \$170,000?

The original estimates for this project were lower, but new information and material inflation has significantly changed the financial implications of this project. The new project scope requires \$170,000 above our current funds raised. The Parish Finance Council is targeting \$170,000 to cover any unexpected contingencies that may develop over the course of construction. Once these bathrooms are renovated, the future focus will shift to improving the elementary school bathrooms, which are in a similar condition. Any unutilized funding for this project will be held for additional bathroom renovations.

### Are there opportunities to reduce the cost of this project?

Patrick Fitzgerald (Ops Director) and the planning team (including members of the Finance Council and parishioners with backgrounds in engineering, construction, and other relevant experience) have worked closely with the architects and general contractors to identify and implement cost saving opportunities. We are lucky to have the talent in our community to confidently execute these projects. The current project scope is the result of those trade-off discussions and leveraged considerable savings.

### What will happen to the current bathroom space once this project is complete?

The current bathrooms may be used until the new facilities are operational. At that time, the fixtures (toilets, sinks, stalls, etc.) will be removed, the lines will be capped off, and the rooms can be used as storage. Long-term, this space can be available for a future strategic project.

## Is It Time to Hand Over the Car Keys?

You may know that stress is natural, and everyone experiences it to some degree. But you may not know what you can As a loved one gets older and their driving skills start to decline, it may be to time for them to get out from behind the wheel. It's often a difficult conversation to have since it's a loss of the senior's independence. They may have been driving all their life, it defines them, or they just love cars. At the end of the day, you want what is best for them and that includes keeping them safe.

I recommend starting the conversation early. If you notice any warning signs that a person's driving abilities are impaired, it's best to bring them up to avoid a tragic circumstance. Those signs include:

- Frequent motor vehicle accidents
- Forgetting how to locate familiar places
- Failing to observe traffic signs
- Making slow or poor decisions in traffic
- Driving at an inappropriate speed
- Becoming angry or confused while driving
- Hitting curbs
- Using poor lane control
- Making errors at intersections
- Confusing the brake and gas pedals
- Returning from a routine drive later than usual
- Forgetting their destination during the drive



During the discussion, show empathy, provide alternatives and be there for them. Stress on their positives and strengths.

Once they are aware of your concern, they can discuss the signs you noticed with their primary care doctor who can treat any underlying conditions. They may even refer them to an occupational therapist who can perform a driver assessment and provide recommendations.

Some people start by limiting their driving to daytime and limiting their drive to destinations within the area. This may work for some, but this is a sign that further professional evaluation is needed.

### Impaired driving isn't just for seniors

We are made to believe that only seniors lose their driving skills, but aging alone does not put a person at risk for unsafe driving. There are several factors to consider that may affect driving ability including:

- Vision
- Hearing
- Cognition
- Medical conditions, for example epilepsy or sleep disorders
- Dexterity, or the ability to move hands and fingers
- Functional deficits, or the inability to complete daily tasks
- Certain medications, especially ones that make you drowsy
- Substance abuse

Holding everyone accountable for their role in recognizing and addressing driving impairment can help keep people safe on the roads.

# Doctor of the Church

\'däk-tər 'əv 'thə ,'chərch\

Doctor, from the Latin *docere*, meaning "to teach"; an eminent teacher of the faith, canonized and recognized as such by the pope or church council. Originally eight in number, four were chosen from the Eastern Church and four from the West. To date there are 37 **church doctors**, including four women.

### **WHY IT MATTERS**

Sometimes in the moral life you need an umpire who has the authority to call it fair or foul. **Doctors of the church** have proven that their careful perspective on matters of faith can be trusted, particularly by their witness of holiness and dedication to learning.

From the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' website: "To be declared a **Doctor of the Church** does not imply that all their writings are free from error but rather that the whole body of their work, taken together serves to advance the cause of Christ and his Church."

### QUESTION OF THE WEEK

### Who are the doctors of the church?

**Doctors of the church** are always canonized saints, defined by three criteria: eminent learning, a high degree of sanctity, and proclamation by a pope or council. Their naming isn't an infallible decision and doesn't presume their writings are free from error. A doctor's primary significance is as Confessor of the faith. That is why martyrs, such as Ignatius and Cyprian, were originally excluded. Irenaeus of Lyon was added in 2022, however, so doctor-martyrs are now a possibility.

Currently, there are 37 **doctors of the church,** with 17 being from religious orders: Five Benedictines; three each of Carmelites, Dominicans, and Franciscans; two Jesuits; and one Redemptorist. Each doctor reveals an avenue of grace through unique achievements in such areas as apologetics, homiletics, history, education, science, art, music, poetry, catechesis, mysticism, morality, and spirituality.

### Follow the doctor's advice

Catherine of Siena transcended the narrow roles to which Medieval laypeople—and women in particular—were subject. She gave wise counsel to popes, negotiated settlements, kept a continuous correspondence with her followers throughout Italy, and composed *The Dialogue*, an account of her conversation with God, which is widely considered a masterpiece of spiritual literature and contributed to her being named a **doctor of the church**. Amazingly she accomplished all this despite being almost completely illiterate! How? She dictated everything.

### **GOSPEL MEDITATION:**

### April 28, 2024 5th Sunday of Easter

My friend and fellow pastor, Father Paul, noticed unsightly, overgrown trees near his parish church. He asked the maintenance crew to cut back the growth, which they happily did, telling him the trees would be much healthier and even fuller after a good pruning. A few days later, Father Paul received a letter from an irate man in the neighborhood who wrote, "Jesus would never prune trees like that. He loves trees, unlike you."

I suspect that the neighbor was not familiar with this week's Gospel in which Jesus says of his Father, "He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit. Every branch that bears fruit he prunes to make it bear more fruit" (John 15:2) I don't mean to pick too much on that fellow. He was perhaps ignorant of arboriculture. But I'd wager his main confusion was the pruning and removing quality of God's love. That confusion afflicts us all to some degree, doesn't it? It is just so darn easy to react negatively when God cuts something out of our lives and assume it's not his work at all. In the moment, all we see is the loss, and not the loving desire for future flourishing.

The cross is the great pruning of Christ's body. Jesus' rising is the brand-new growth. It is God's promise to us that all the painful pruning in life is leading us somewhere beautiful. What has been cut back or out in your life? A friend, an opportunity, a sense of certainty, a job, health, a relationship? This week, offer those dry branches to the one who lovingly prunes us in order to make our lives burst with verdant growth.
